(Students age 6+) We strive to cultivate an atmosphere conducive to learning and cultivate an environment of serious study, especially among older students. Students should dress modestly and seek to glorify the Lord through their dress. We encourage families to items from our Land's End catalog, but it is not required.

Boys

Collared shirts or Good Shepherd t-shirts, properly fitting and tucked in
Pants for boys should be properly fitting, worn properly and not show undergarments
Trousers with belt loops should be worn with a belt.
Modest golf-style shorts are permitted.
Hair should not be longer than the top of the collar.

Girls

Modest skirt, shorts, dress-casual slacks, or skirt or dress
No spaghetti straps, sleeveless tops
Tops should not show undergarments
Midriffs should not show

Both boys and girls

No blue jeans for GSH co-op
No shirts with writing or pictures
Any tattoos or piercings (other than ear for girls) should not be visible.
Jewelry worn should be modest.
Heavy makeup is inappropriate for co-op
Hair colored in colors that are not

Behavior Standards

First and foremost, remember Who we're representing. We should be orderly (I Cor. 14:40), peaceable, and honoring of parents and elders. We are kind to one another (Ephesians 4:32).
